

## **Program Release Notes 2.1.3.8**


On 19 August 2021, MilitaryChildCare.com (MCC) was upgraded to include several enhancements. The enhancements are summarized in the table below and additional details are provided in subsequent sections.

Enhancement	Details
Reports	The <b>24/7</b> and Extended Care Demand Report is available. This report identifies the children in need of 24/7 or extended care whose sponsor completed the interest form while searching for care at an installation where 24/7 and extended care are not available.
Where Children are Receiving Care Text Box	Families will be allowed, but not required, to enter a comment about the care their child is receiving regardless of which option is selected.
Provider Long- Term Closure Reason	The list of reasons for provider long-term closure has been updated. The complete list of reasons includes Personal Leave, Certification Suspended, and Provider PCSing. To request a provider's status be updated to long-term closure, please submit the <a href="FCC Provider Update">FCC Provider Update</a> <a href="Request Form">Request Form</a> available on the Training Center Resources page.

## 24/7 and Extended Care Demand Report

The 24/7 and Extended Care Demand report identifies the children for whom the 24/7 and extended care interest form was completed while searching for care at an installation where 24/7 and/or extended care are not available. The report includes the family's work schedule.
