



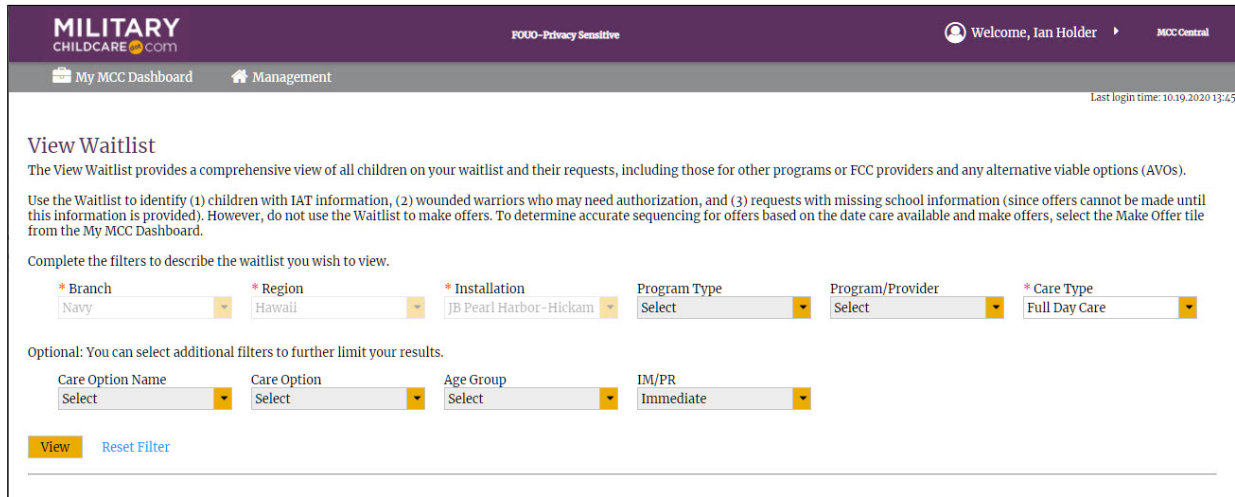
Program Release Notes 2.1.1

On 17 October 2020, MilitaryChildCare.com (MCC) was upgraded to include several enhancements. The enhancements are summarized in the table below and additional details are provided in subsequent sections.

Enhancement Area	Details
Backdate RFC Date	<p>A new role was added to allow select users to backdate the Request for Care (RFC) date when adding a request for a child. This role allows program users to create a new request and backdate the RFC date for supplanted families.</p> <p>Review the appropriate Position Group Overview document available on the Training Center Resources Page to determine which position groups have been assigned the new role: https://www.mcccentral.com/training-center/resources</p>
Reconfirm Request	<p>The system has been updated so a program user cannot reconfirm requests on the family’s behalf unless the household is complete. If this situation occurs, remind the family to complete their household profile and then the family or program user can reconfirm the requests.</p>
View Waitlist Filter Updates	<p>The View Waitlist filter now includes a primary and secondary filter. Care Option Name, School Served (when applicable), and IM/PR have been added and appear in the secondary View Waitlist filter.</p>
View Waitlist Results Updates	<p>System updates to the View Waitlist results now allow program users to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Sort on Sponsor’s Name ▪ Search by Sponsor’s Name ▪ Show only children who have IAT comments ▪ Identify children on the cusp (i.e., children within 30 days of the next age group as of today’s date)
Program and Care Option Report	<p>The Program and Care Option report was modified so users with the appropriate AOR can generate the report at the Branch and Region levels in addition to Installation and Program levels.</p>
MCCYN	<p>Navy and USMC households that have a fee assistance request can now see that request on their My Child Care page, and can cancel and update the DCN for the request. These same families will see fee assistance offers on their My Child Care page and Dashboard, but will not be able to accept or decline these offers. At the end of October, Navy and USMC households with fee assistance requests will be required to reconfirm their request on a regular basis.</p>

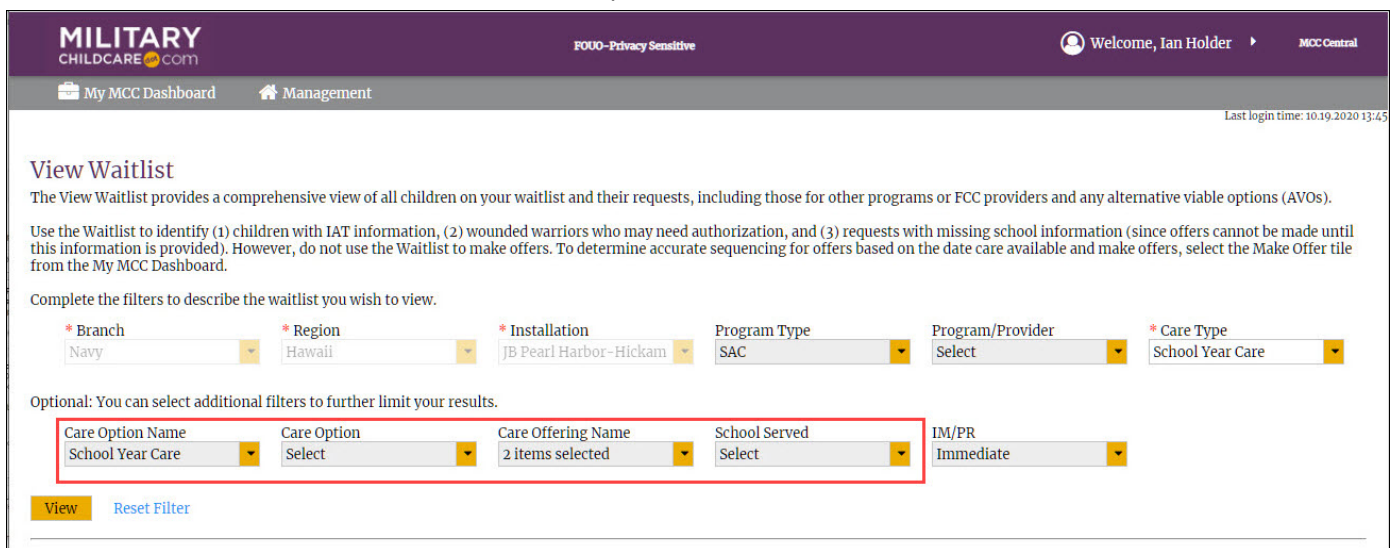
View Waitlist Filter Updates

When selecting the View Waitlist tile from the dashboard, program users will see the filters in two sections: primary and secondary filters. Two new optional filters, found in the secondary View Waitlist filter section, allow program users to filter on Care Option Name, School Transportation (when applicable), and IM/PR.



The secondary filter includes a School Served drop-down which is a multi-select option. School Served only displays if the Care Type or Care Option selected includes a Care Offering of Before/After School.

- Selecting 'No Transportation Needed' from the School Served drop-down displays children in the View Waitlist results that do not require transportation to and from the program and school.
- Selecting 'School Unknown' from the School Served drop-down displays children in the View Waitlist results where the family has stated that they do not know where their child will be attending.
- If no value is selected from the School Served drop-down, all children with a request for the Care Offering of Before/After School will display in the View Waitlist results regardless of the school selected. The View Waitlist results will also include children with 'No Transportation Needed' or 'School Unknown' selected.



View Waitlist Results Updates

The View Waitlist results have been updated and allow program users to:

- Sort by Sponsor's Name
- Search by Sponsor's Name
- Show only children who have 'IAT' comments
- Identify children on the cusp (i.e., children within 30 days of the next age group as of today's date) by an icon next to the 'Age Group'

View Waitlist

The View Waitlist provides a comprehensive view of all children on your waitlist and their requests, including those for other programs or FCC providers and any alternative viable options (AVOs).

However, do not use the Waitlist to make offers. To determine accurate sequencing for offers based on the date care available and make offers, select the Make Offer tile from the My MCC Dashboard.
