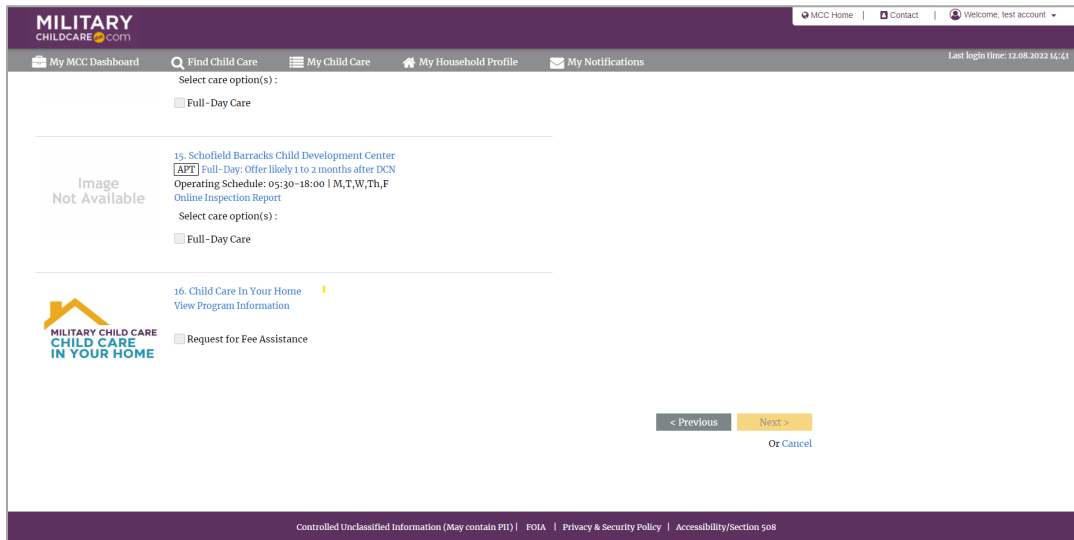


Figure 2: Informational text Modal for 'View Child Care in Your Home Information' link

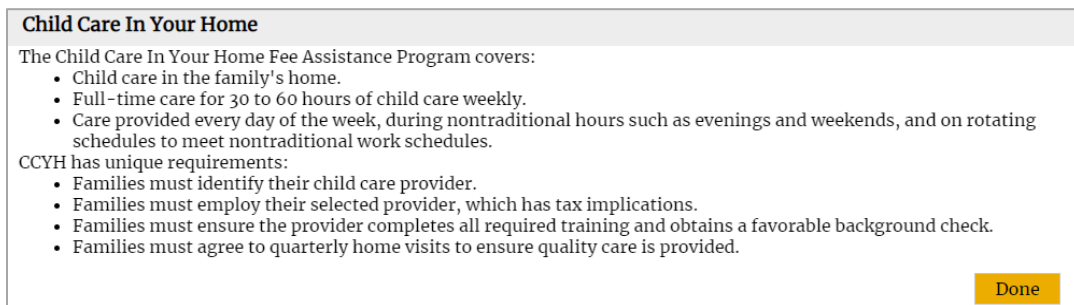


Figure 3: Informational text Modal when selecting 'Fee Assistance' care option for the Child Care In Your Home program

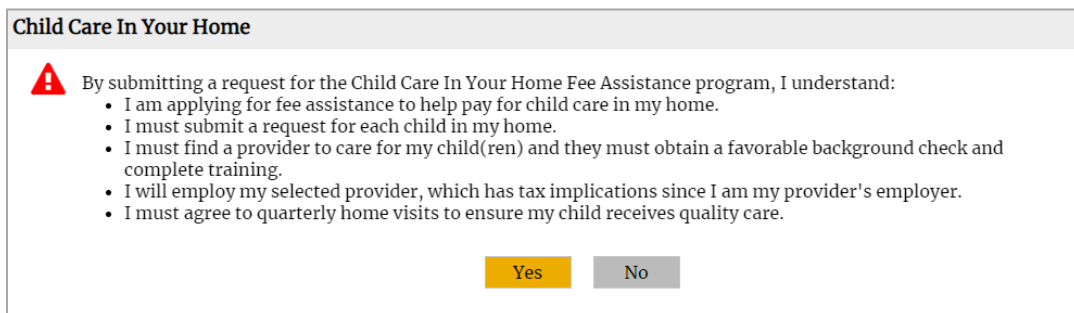


Figure 4: Request Received for Child Care In Your Home Fee Assistance

Request Received for Child Care In Your Home Fee Assistance

Hello,

Thank you for your interest in the Department of Defense's Child Care In Your Home Fee Assistance Program. While this is not an offer for the program, this email serves as confirmation that your request has been received and provides additional information. The program supports eligible families seeking full-time child care in their own home, using between 30 hours to 60 hours of full-time weekly child care, including weekends and rotating shifts to meet the nontraditional work schedules of military families. The Child Care In Your Home Fee Assistance is meant to offset the cost of child care for eligible military families and will not cover the entire cost of child care.

You are responsible for finding and employing your own child care in your home provider. To search for a provider, you may use the expanded child care service available at no cost through Military OneSource by copying and pasting this URL into your browser <https://www.militaryonesource.mil/family-relationships/parenting-and-children/military-childcare-services/>. If you receive an offer for fee assistance, a Third Party Administrator (Child Care Aware of America) will work with your provider to validate they meet the program requirements. Program requirements for providers include favorable background checks and required training, which includes but is not limited to CPR, first aid, and child abuse prevention. Also, you and your provider must commit to monitoring and oversight through quarterly home visits.

You may receive an offer email if a space becomes available. In the meantime, you may search for a child care provider and determine if this program is right for your family. You may contact Military OneSource tax consultants, via this URL <https://www.militaryonesource.mil/financial-legal/tax-resource-center/miltax-military-tax-services/> if you have questions about tax implications for parents who employ providers in their home.

3. Select a child care provider for your home. To search for a provider, you may use, but are not limited to, the expanded child care service available at no cost through Military OneSource by copying and pasting this URL into your browser <https://www.militaryonesource.mil/family-relationships/parenting-and-children/military-childcare-services/>.
 - At a minimum, the provider must be eligible to work in the U.S. (a U.S. citizen or Legal Permanent Resident), be at least 18 years of age, hold a high school diploma or equivalent, be able to read, speak, and write English. The provider may be a family member, however there are limitations. For full provider requirement details visit: www.militarychildcare.com/ccyh.
 - Child Care Aware of America will validate your provider has completed a favorable background check and required training.
 - Contact Military OneSource tax consultants via this URL <https://www.militaryonesource.mil/financial-legal/tax-resource-center/miltax-military-tax-services/> if you have questions about the tax implications of employing a child care provider in your home.

You must submit your supporting documents to Child Care Aware of America within 5 business days of accepting this offer, even if you have not yet selected your child care provider. Once this information has been received and reviewed, a Child Care Aware of America staff member will contact you to discuss the eligibility verification, application, and provider approval process. If your supporting documentation is not received within 5 business days, your offer for child care fee assistance may be cancelled and your request removed from the waitlist.
