

MCC 2.3 Release Notes

On 19 November 2022, MilitaryChildCare.com (MCC) was upgraded to include several new features described below.

Enhancement Area	Details
Household Profile Update: Part-Time Student	Part-time student will display as a spouse employment type on the household profile when the family selects "student" (see figures 1 and 2 below).
Household Profile Update: Coast Guard	Active Duty Coast Guard members will be able to identify themselves as Active Duty Military with a branch of Coast Guard when they are completing the Sponsor Eligibility Type or the Spouse Employment Status sections of the Household Profile (see figure 3 below).
Updates to Find Care for MCCYN OCONUS- OCONUS limitation	If a family is geographically dispersed, the Military Child Care in Your Neighborhood (MCCYN) program will only show if the family is searching for care within the continental United States, Alaska, Hawaii, and Puerto Rico.
Reconfirm Notification (Remove MCCYN Text)	Information about the Military Child Care in Your Neighborhood (MCCYN) program was removed from the reconfirm notification and reminder emails.
